RAINFOREST REWILD

2 x 60' / HD / In Production

In this first-of-its-kind blue-chip documentary series, experience Central America like never before! Wildlife like jaguars, spider monkeys, and peccaries are rewilding the fragmented rainforests right in front of our cameras!



In this blue chip miniseries, we explore nature's come-back power. Modern-day sees forests fragmented and disconnected. But when left alone and given enough space, the animals will rewild the forest themselves. Told through the eyes of forest-dwelling capuchins, we get the world's first glimpse into this hidden world.

Every animal they lead us to is busy rewilding the forest. White-lipped peccaries are engineers who create mud wallows that provide water for plants and animal kin. Great green macaws and spider monkeys spread seeds, planting trees as they forage. Jaguars feast on Olive Ridley turtles on the edge of the forest where nutrient cycling feeds the rainforest. And breathtaking sequences of busy amphibians reveal how microhabitats become building blocks of a healthy ecosystem. With over 2000 hours of mind-blowing 4K footage, including never-before filmed behaviors, these are the stories of the true wildlife heroes.



CUTTING THE LINE

A kayaking tour guide and his family rescue entangled seals along Namibia's Skeleton Coast, evolving into a unique environmental organization tackling a global plastic crisis.



Cutting the Line follows the story of Naude Dreyer, a kayaking tour guide based in Walvis Bay, Namibia, who starts rescuing seals entangled in fishing line, packaging straps and other ocean pollution, ultimately saving them from an agonising death.

When his wife, Katja, discovers what he is doing, they start an environmental organisation to raise awareness about the devastating effect of plastic pollution by documenting the rescues and sharing them through social media.

The response they get from around the world is overwhelming and the organisation quickly evolves into a full-time operation. Despite this, the Dreyers are acutely aware that they face a daunting challenge, specifically the formidable threat posed by the world's reliance on plastic; the fishing industry; and the magnitude of the global plastic crisis. This is put into stark relief and illustrated by their successes and failures in the field, and the contrasting emotions the rescues bring out between hope and despair.



MYSTERIES OF THE RED SEA

What has changed since bears were rarely seen? Through gripping characters and stunning wildlife cinematography, we delve into the experience of living alongside this unpredictable apex predator, blending fast-paced action with profound storytelling.

SAVING GIANTS: MALELANE - ELEPHANT RESCUE

This documentary follows the heroic efforts of southern Africa's most exceptional conservationists as they battle against the odds to save the continent's most iconic animals.

Conservationists launch an emergency operation to save five elephants from being shot after they break out of their reserve and cross a national highway. The South African government faces the choice of moving the animals or killing them. Featuring wildlife transportation expert Kester Vickery and veterinarians Dr. Dave Cooper and Dr. Peter Rodgers, this documentary showcases a rapid elephant relocation.



A LIFE AMONG ELEPHANTS

60 years ago, almost nothing was known of elephants in the wild. But then one young Scottish biologist changed that forever.

In 1965, Iain Douglas-Hamilton arrived in Tanzania to live alongside African elephants, joined by his wife Oria and daughters Saba and Dudu. Cherishing matriarch Boadicea and young mother Virgo as family, their paradise was disrupted by an ivory poaching epidemic. Transitioning from scientist to conservationist, Iain became a lone crusader against the ivory trade, banned in 1989. This documentary highlights his inspiring journey and ongoing work with a new generation of Kenyan conservationists.



KUI BURI - THAILAND'S HIDDEN EDEN

This is the story of a Garden of Eden, hidden deep within the jungles of Southeast Asia. A national park that's home to an almost unimaginable variety of animals.

Not only noteworthy for its countless species, Kui Buri National Park in southwestern Thailand is also known for its abundance of large animals, like Asian elephants and wild bovines.

The scarce gaur lives here, the world's largest bovine species and it is also home to the smaller, ruddy banteng. At some time in the past, gaurs and bantengs intermingled, mated, and reproduced. The result is an extremely rare hybrid – the Krathing Daeng. The elephants and especially the rare Krathing Daeng might be the highlights of the national park, but with all its bounty of species including hornbills, Asiatic wild dogs, barking deer, and lar gibbons as well as creative nature protection measures, Kui Buri is a true success story; it's become a model for national parks worldwide.

RIVERWOODS

Narrated by Scottish Actor and Director Peter Eter Capaldi (*Doctor Who*, *The Devil's Hour*), Riverwoods explores the complex relationship between Scotland's Atlantic salmon and its natural woodlands.

Riverwoods is the story of a fish that lives in the forest. And in the soil that feeds the forest. And in the predators, scavengers and even herbivores of the forest. Scotland's Atlantic salmon - the King of Fish - is not only the ultimate angler's prize, but a key building block in a complex forest ecosystem. But in return, salmon need the support of a rich and diverse landscape that stretches far beyond the banks of the river. Over many centuries, the loss of Scotland's natural woodlands, and much of the wildlife that shaped them, has profoundly changed our rivers and their ability to support the huge salmon runs that once flourished. Today, this magnificent creature so symbolic of Scotland's spectacular, cascading rivers, is threatened like never before.

Riverwoods shines a light on the perilous state of Scotland's salmon and tells the compelling story of an inextricable and extraordinary relationship, between fish and forest.



EUROPE'S AMAZON

Everyone knows the Danube. But do you know its major tributary, leading from White Summits towards the Black Sea?

Where the Drava and Danube meet lies Central Europe's most spectacular inland delta. Hidden behind the Iron Curtain for decades, the Drava delta is a secret world of wetlands, forests, and vibrant wildlife. It gathers waters and sediments from glaciers, lakes, woodlands, and valleys, flowing into the Danube before reaching the Black Sea.

KATAVI - AFRICA'S FALLEN PARADISE

Extreme weather forces hippos, crocodiles, and lions into conflict and unlikely alliances in Tanzania's remote Katavi National Park.

We are about to enter an unknown realm. A hidden place, isolated from time. Katavi National Park in Southern Tanzania. A wild place at the end of the world. The sheer richness of life found here is staggering. Hidden amongst its deep cracks and fissures, diverse communities live jowl-to-jowl. Hippos, Crocodiles, and Lions may live together, but their viewpoints are contrary. They are warring neighbors, forced together through necessity.

SAN DIEGO - AMERICA'S WILDEST CITY

San Diego's mountains, ocean, and desert create America's most biodiverse landscape, attracting millions of visitors to this city where nature and urban life collide.

For thousands of years, the Pacific Ocean, desert, and mountains created diverse habitats teeming with life. Humans have been part of this ecosystem for millennia, but in the last 200 years, our population has surged. Now, modern humans reshape the landscape to meet our needs, creating a new, human-constructed ecosystem. In San Diego, this presents unique challenges and opportunities for the wildlife sharing space with us.





WILD VIENNA

Vienna, a top European tourist destination, is also one of the world's most biologically active cities.

In the imperial palaces, ancient churches, and gardens of Vienna, a remarkable variety of wildlife thrives. The city's vast green areas, including the Vienna Woods and Danube wetlands, are home to wild boars, roe deer, foxes, and kestrels, while beavers and herons inhabit its streams. The 21-kilometer Danube Island serves as both flood control and recreation, hosting rare European pond turtles and invasive red-eared terrapins.



GOLDEN EAGLE - CALL OF THE WILD

On average, only one of five fledglings will make it past its first winter. "Golden Eagle – Call of the Wild" lets the viewer feel the intense struggle to survive the extreme conditions of the high Alps.

Throughout an entire year, we follow the young bird on an adventurous odyssey from tender parental care to independence and on its challenging search for a territory of its own. Intimate images let us feel the heat of the battle when the youngster is attacked by hostile raptors, and we watch break-neck air attacks on animals of prey.



WELCOME TO THE NEIGHBOURHOOD

Explore how rapid urbanization impacts biodiversity as animals adapt to city life, reshaping ecosystems and human health.

Today's rapid urbanization pressures cities, impacting biodiversity, ecosystems, and public health. Blackbirds sing louder, urban foxes have shorter snouts, and white-footed mice now digest fast food. This documentary showcases fascinating animal behaviors, stunning cityscapes, and innovative scientific projects, revealing new connections in urban living.

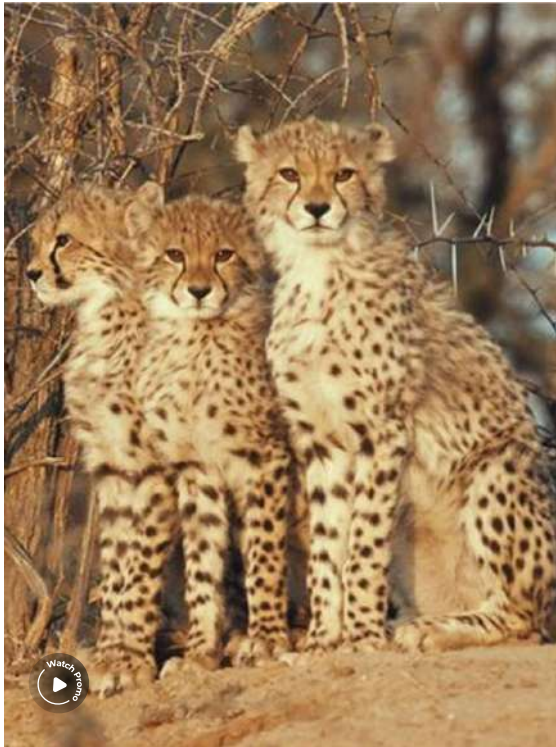


PATRICK AND THE WHALE

Patrick had a life-changing encounter with a female sperm whale in Dominica, which he named "Dolores." He felt she was genuinely trying to communicate. Returning to find her, Patrick uses stunning underwater footage to explore sperm whale intelligence and their relationship with humankind. The film follows his personal journey and examines his sacrifices in his quest to connect with one of the ocean's largest creatures.



A CHEETAH'S PRIDE

A never-seen-before wildlife phenomenon is happening in the Samara Karoo Reserve on the plains of South Africa's semi-desert wilderness: the appearance of an extraordinary cheetah family: Two mothers, with nine cubs!

In June, 2020, two cheetah mothers met by chance. One is an experienced mother and effective huntress with five cubs. The other mother has four cubs, but she's younger and hindered by a blind eye, but affectionate and patient. After the initial meeting, the cubs become mixed up, resulting in one mother adopting the other's cubs as her own. Stranger still; the mothers meet again and, instead of going their separate ways, stay together. Female cheetahs are solitary, this hybrid-family is a world first.

The family would go on to endure what can only be described as a wildlife soap opera. They face the many dangers of the African bush, endure starvation and injury, overcome abandonment and loss, cubs rise to insurmountable challenges and look out for one another. One mother struggles while the other succeeds, but they need each other if they're to keep all nine cubs alive.

DETHRONED

There is a connection to big cats that runs deep within us. Throughout the history of mankind, we have looked upon them with awe, wonder, reverence, and respect.

Worshipped by the ancients, witnessed as gods – symbols of power so mighty they commanded the construction of our most impressive monuments – big cats arguably mean more to humanity than any other animal. Yet as we lose touch with our history, our relationship with big cats sits at a critical point, and we risk reducing them to a shell of their former symbolic significance.

DETHRONED is a story of rediscovery, following photo-journalist Aaron Gekoski across our planet in an attempt to uncover where we have parted ways with the big cats and what could happen if we continue to allow these great creatures to be traded, commodified, and enslaved, to serve the purposes of humanity.

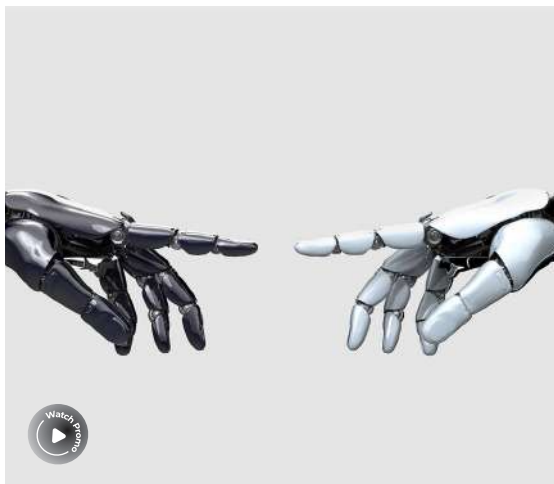

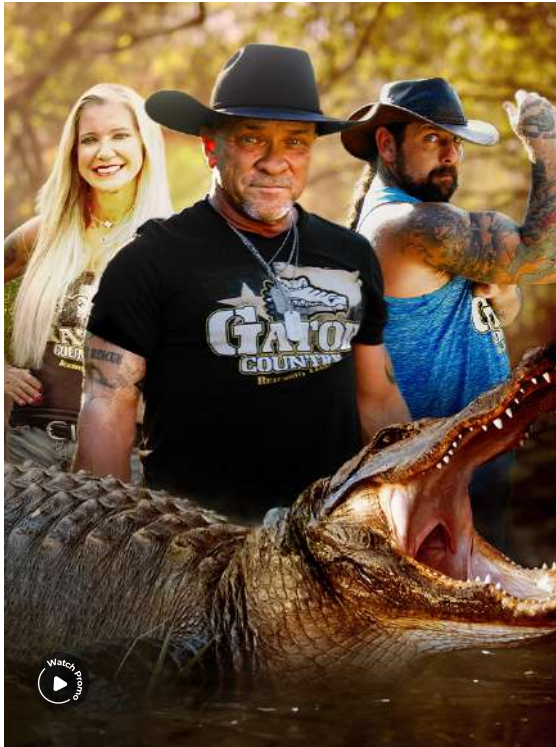

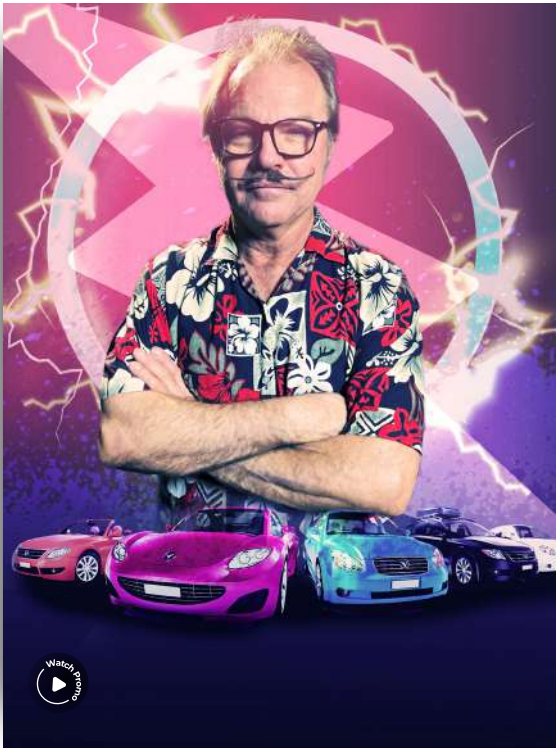

This documentary delves into the violations of international regulations, ghost ships and omertà behind a lucrative business aimed at Japan, which still utilises archaic and cruel methods of hunting these majestic creatures

In 2022 Iceland killed 160 Fin whales, the second largest animal in the world, despite the international whaling commission (IWC) deeming it an endangered species and banning its hunting worldwide. How is it then that the slaughter continues?

A crew from Swiss television RSI went to Iceland, intercepted the whalers and documented their cruel hunting methods. The result is an investigation that highlights a system of omertà spread throughout the country, a silent complicity behind which there is a multi-million dollar business aimed exclusively at the Japanese market. Whaling is not a tradition for Iceland, as it is for Norway. The meat of this cetacean is in fact practically all exported to Japan, purely for business. A very strong contrast for a nation that focuses on ecological and nature tourism, where one of the sectors that generates the most income is whale watching.

Another controversial aspect also emerges from the investigation. The problematic nature of the controls is confirmed in an exclusive interview with the president of the IWC (International Whaling Commission), who is also an official of the Federal Veterinary Office in Bern? The journalistic investigation "The Whaler" has contributed to the suspension, in summer 2023, of Fin whale killing in Iceland.



A GAME OF SECRETS

To name just a few, Cristiano Ronaldo is convicted for tax fraud and Manchester City banned from the Champions League. Nélito Lucas, a top Portuguese agent in business with Kazakh oligarchs - and one of Football Leaks' main targets - receives an offer from a Russian hacker: Make a generous donation and the leaks of confidential documents and leaks will stop. After a high stakes meeting, police raid a scrappy Budapest apartment. Out walks a teenage-looking Portuguese named Rui Pinto in handcuffs, worn-out sneakers and a backpack full of hard drives.

When Ulrich Larsen aka The Mole enters the international North Korean Friendship Association (KFA), he quickly jumps the organization's rank and becomes friendly with KFA's almighty President Alejandro Cao de Benós. When Cao de Benós tells The Mole that he is looking for possible investors into North Korea. The Mole introduces the mysterious "Mr. James" (played by Jim Latrache-Qvortrup), who pretends to be a possible investor. Cao de Benós gets all excited about Mr. James and the possibility of selling drugs and weapons from North Korea, so he arranges for The Mole and Mr. James to travel to North Korea. Filmed in secrecy over a period of 10 years, THE MOLE is the most disturbing story of the 21st century and will make you wonder if the world will ever be the same again.



GONE WITH THE FOUR WINDS: EMIGRATION STORIES

Locals of the village of Fondo Negro live scattered in all directions. 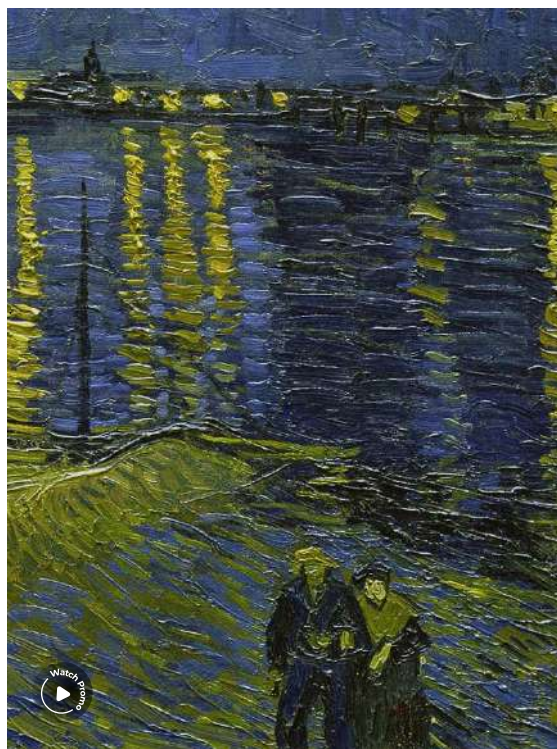

VAN GOGH: POETS & LOVERS

FRANS HALS: MASTER OF JOY

This documentary explores how Frans Hals defied 17th-century Dutch norms by painting rare smiles, revealing the cultural significance of laughter in his time and its meaning for us today.

Together with Pulitzer Prize winner *Benjamin Moser*, writer *Arthur Japin*, art historians and such as *Katja Kleinert* (Gemäldegalerie) and *Friso Lammertse* (Rijksmuseum) and *Mariggje Rikken* (Frans Hals Museum), the internationally acclaimed artist *Glenn Brown* and philosopher *Philipp Hübl*, the film looks at the phenomenon of laughter in the art of Frans Hals – and its function in our lives.

Of all the artists who worked in the Netherlands in the 17th century, Frans Hals – along with Rembrandt and Vermeer – is the best known. Nevertheless, he never achieved the popularity of his two contemporaries. One of the reasons for this might have been that he did not paint history paintings but only portraits and that he usually did not show people – as was the fashion – in a serious manner.

Frans Hals' pictures are populated by figures who laugh heartily, grin, and can hardly hold themselves together for joy. Figures that at the same time are not consumed into caricature, like the bowling figures in Jan Steen's paintings, which served as a moral admonition to the lower classes: "You look so ugly when you laugh!" To Frans Hals' contemporaries, laughing seemed improper and was a sign that someone belonged to the lower class.

Art has long been seen as serious, with the belief that good art must come out of suffering. Rembrandt's gloomy paintings, depicting dark themes, reinforce this idea. Laughter, by contrast, has been rare in art. In modern life, however, smiling faces dominate, especially on social media, where happiness is almost obligatory. Yet, seriousness remains valued as a sign of respect and sovereignty. Society clearly defines when laughter is appropriate, but our bodies don't always follow these rules.



JOHN SINGER SARGENT - FASHION & SWAGGER
